Combined screen (86-92% DR, 3-5% false positive rate) Positive screen defined as risk 1:190 or greater																				
Part1 serum NT																				
Chorionic Villous Sampling 1% procedure related loss rate																				
Nuchal translucency 70-75% DR, 5% false positive rate																				
Quad screen (70% DR, 5% false positive rate) Positive screen defined as risk 1:200 or greater																				
Maternal serum aFP 75% NTD detection (2.5 MoM), 3% false positives																				
Amniocentesis 1% procedure related loss rate																				
Targeted ultrasound																				
Fetal echocardiogram																				

DR = detection rate for Down syndrome

False positive rate = percentage of women with a "positive" test who DO NOT have a fetus with Down Syndrome
